EXCLUSION ZONE

We've defined an exclusion zone that stops other graphic elements interfering with the AOSH CSS logotype. The minimum space between the logo and other element is the half of the AOSH CSS logo's height all around.

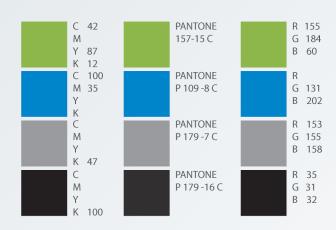


MINIMUM SIZE
