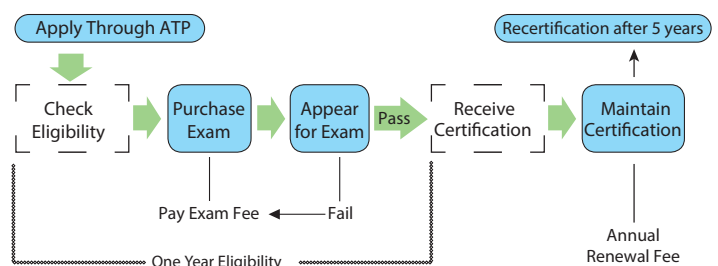

- 4- Hazard identification and control – 40%
- 5 Leadership & training – %15
- 6 Emergency preparedness management – %12
